

FEATURED MARQUES OF THE 2017 BRITISH MOTORING FESTIVAL

This year's British Motoring Festival will designate two categories of vehicles as Featured Marques: (1) Models Manufactured in 1967; and (2) Orphan Marques.

Models Manufactured in 1967

Acknowledging this year's 150th Anniversary of Canada, the Festival will honour models that were manufactured a half-century ago during the country's Centennial year.
